► What is the Paula E. Hess Humanitarian Scholarship?

This scholarship fund was named in honor of one of the C.A.R.E. founders and Chairwoman Emeritus, Paula E. Hess. Funds are provided for distributions to C.A.R.E. survivors and/or their immediate families by the C.A.R.E. Board.

Ms. Hess was an executive business woman dedicated to improving the economic and professional status of women. The number and amount of scholarships awarded each year will vary based on the needs of interested and qualified clients.

Scholarship funds may be used for:

- GED studies and testing
- Associate, Bachelor, or Master degrees
- Vocational training and/or certification



Scholarship Application Requirements

1. Complete and return the Paula E. Hess Scholarship application.
2. Complete the required budget form.
3. Verify enrollment by providing a copy of registration forms, or payment receipts.
4. Provide an overview of the degree, course or certification description.
5. Provide two confidential letters for recommendation in support of the application.

Survivors and Success

- Vocational education and job certification help survivors gain first-time or full-time employment to maintain independent lives from former abusers.
- Access to resources and education help survivors build economic resiliency so their families are more likely to remain safe and secure.
